Greetings from your friendly TTS customer service representatives!

An unseasonably cool summer and fall have made it easy to start thinking ahead to the show season and the Ninth Annual Titletown Train Show! Enclosed is your application form for display/exhibit/layout space. [If you have received this in error and are planning to sell merchandise, please request a Vendor application at the phone number or email above.] Applications can also be found at our website [www.ttsgblc.com](http://www.ttsgblc.com).

If you have a flexible arrangement, please give us options for size; the more displays we can include, the better it is for everyone. As last year, we do not anticipate using the “Resch Connector”, so our space is that much more limited. Because of those things, we strongly discourage “layout creep”: the tendency of some layouts to want to increase in size every year. As usual, layout applications will be processed on a first-come, first-serve basis by scale. However, those that we don’t have room for are automatically guaranteed a spot at the following year’s show (if they so choose). This is a policy we started last year to help make things as fair as possible given our limited floor area and the imperfect “snail mail” system.

**New information for 2010:** Please note that our facility management (PMI) inventories everything during the show. They will charge extra for every electrical plug used, so please make sure you are only using ONE (with your own power strip connected). If you absolutely need more than one plug (remember, a standard duplex receptacle counts as TWO plugs!), note that we may pass through the charges to your display.

Also, PMI is in the process of replacing Shopko Hall tables as the old ones wear out. The new ones are white plastic, similar to what many of you purchase and bring along for yourselves. As such, please make sure yours are labeled (on the bottom) or PMI might try to inventory and charge for them! Also note that the new tables are 24” wide, not 30”; we are trying to reserve the older 30” tables for our paying vendors. However, if you absolutely positively cannot work with 24” tables, now is the time to let us know!

We will have representatives at Trainfest and Mad City again this year, so if you have any questions, please stop by EngineHouse Services (Paul) or the NEWER Industries layout (Todd). Expect to hear from us by early March, at which time we’ll be sending out the final show information packets and such. Until then, if we don’t see you, have a great winter and holiday season!
