Greetings from your friendly TTS customer service representatives!

An unseasonably cool summer and fall have made it easy to start thinking ahead to the show season and the Ninth Annual Titletown Train Show! Enclosed is your application form for vendor/shop/selling space. [If you have received this in error and are planning to display or have a layout, please request an Exhibitor application at the phone number or email above.] Applications can also be found at our website www.ttsqbllc.com.

We have adjusted contract terms this year due to rising costs from our facility management (PMI); electrical and phone costs are pass-thru. Please note that PMI conducts an inventory during the show and will charge if you are using more than one electrical plug, so please make sure one is sufficient (with a power strip); if not, please mark as such on the application. Wireless internet access is also available, but we recommend other arrangements as the facility charges \$150(!) for secure access. As usual we will do our best to accommodate your needs.

New information for 2010: PMI is in the process of replacing Shopko Hall tables as the old ones wear out. The new ones are white plastic, similar to what many of you purchase and bring along for yourselves. As such, please make sure yours are labeled (on the bottom) or PMI might try to inventory and charge for them! Also note that the new tables are 24" wide, not 30"; we believe there should be enough of the old 30" tables to accommodate our vendors yet this year, but just to be sure, if you absolutely positively cannot work with 24" tables, now is the time to let us know!

I've thrown in the Name Badge form on the reverse side of this letter; if you already know who to put down, by all means send it along. As usual, the limit is 15 names; we can create more badges for you than that, but at a reduced admission price of only \$5. We will have representatives at Trainfest and Mad City again this year, so if you have any questions, please stop by EngineHouse Services (Paul) or the NEWER Industries layout (Todd) if you don't see us roaming around.

Expect to hear from us by early March, at which time we'll be sending out the final show information packets and such. Until then, if we don't see you, have a great winter and holiday season!
